Dear Parent/Carer,

Your child has been identified as being a pupil who could benefit greatly from attending the UniTracks program at Warwick University.

The UniTracks programme is designed to work with pupils who have the potential to be accepted at University. Their acceptance onto the course would be a huge achievement.

Throughout the four years, pupils will attend workshops during the academic year and will have access to Warwick University facilities with academic tutors and mentors.

The course is designed to nurture the knowledge and skills that will harness future academic success and briefly comprises of the following:

Year 8 – Exploring University Life

There is a focus on Arts and Humanities subjects, pupils work in teams to produce research work that helps them to understand the information that they will receive about higher level education.

Year 9 - Developing Skills

Pupils will work in teams to produce a documentary about local history. Pupils will have access to all levels of support, this includes working with the University's film department!

Year 10 – Working to equip pupils with skills for future success

Pupils will be allocated academic mentors who will support them through their studies both in school and through some University workshops.

Year 11 - Mentor support for academic help

Support becomes more bespoke and additional tutoring will be available throughout the year.

Workshops run for six Saturdays throughout the year, travel and lunch is provided through the University so there is no charge. More details are provided through the application process.
