I am writing with an invitation for your child to attend some targeted English intervention sessions that will run in addition to our main intervention sessions on a Wednesday.

Your child has been identified as requiring some additional help and support to secure at least a Grade 5 in English and we would like to offer some sessions that will take place on **Thursdays after school from 3:20 – 4:20pm**.
